DEBIT & CREDIT CARD SKIMMING

This happens when attempts to hijack your personal information and your identity by tampering with ATM machines. Fraudsters set up a device that is capable of capturing the debit card magnetic stripe and keypad information from the ATM, then sell this information to criminals who use it to create new cards with your account numbers.

PROTECT YOURSELF first by reducing your risk at ATMsuse machines from institutions you know and trust. A thief has to be able to use the data it's gathered, which is easier in settings where there's less traffic and no surveillance cameras. Additionally, if you notice a change at an ATM you use routinely, such as a color difference in the card reader or a gap where something appears to be glued onto the slot where you insert your card, that's a warning sign to find another machine.
