Safety & Security Remain Our Chief Goal

Cyber-attacks against the US financial system are very much in the news lately. These cyber-attacks are the focus of concern for both government and industry, as experts seek ways to identify the perpetrators and stop the attacks. As a Credit Union member, it is important for you to know the facts about these events. The key facts to remember are:

A. Your personal information is safe. B. Your money is safe.

What can you do to protect yourself?

1. Strong passwords - experts advise a combination of letters and numbers,

and advise against using easily guessed passwords such as birthdays or home addresses.

2. Anti-Virus Protections - make sure the anti-virus software on your computer is current and scans your email as it is received.

- 3. Email Safety email is generally not encrypted so be wary of sending any sensitive information
 - such as account numbers or other personal information in this way.
- 4. Sign Off and Log Out Always log off by following the credit union's secured area exit procedures.
 - 5. Monitor your accounts when you check your account regularly,

you can let your credit union know immediately if you encounter anything that doesn't seem right.
